1. Each farm product must have been grown by the exhibitor in the current year.
2. All entries must be in place between 1:00pm and 5:00pm on Wednesday.
3. **There is no entry fee in this department.**
4. Any exhibit that is improperly classified or does not meet the department and premium list rules will be disqualified.
5. An exhibitor may enter only one item per class.
6. If a class receives fewer than three entries, the judge may award premiums at their discretion when quality warrants it.
7. Entries may include unripe products in classes where harvest timing does not align with the Fair dates.
8. Class 69 pays \$6. \$5. \$3. All other classes pay \$3. \$2. & \$1. Except class 77 which pays \$10. \$5. & \$3.
9. Exhibits will be released after 2:00 pm Sunday. Anyone leaving before this time without the permission of the Superintendent will forfeit all premiums.
