Exhibitors are required to follow all Health Requirements. Animals must be accompanied by a Certificate of Veterinary Inspection signed by an accredited veterinarian with each animal individually identified. Animals will be inspected for contagious conditions. **Entries must be postmarked by June 15th!** Late entries will be accepted for **\$10 each**. Entry fees are \$3 per calf/heifer class & \$4 per cow class.

****Dairy may arrive Wednesday July 23rd, between 2pm-4pm ONLY and July 24th, between 9am-11am ONLY. ****

The show will begin promptly at 9am on Friday, July 25th. Entries may leave after the show but are encouraged to remain on display until Sunday at 4pm. Please inform the superintendent of your plans. Stalls must be cleaned out to receive premiums.

Copies of registration papers must be included when making entry. Only 2 premiums will be given per exhibitor per class. All animals shown in group classes must have been shown in individual classes.
