Open Show Entry Fee: \$1.50 per class

LATE ENTRIES WILL BE CHARGED AN ADDITIONAL \$2.00 PER ENTRY

1. All entries must be postmarked by July 20th.
2. Open to registered or grade stock.
3. Rabbits left on display for the duration of the fair will be fed & watered by the Superintendent unless other arrangements are made in advance. Exhibits are encouraged to stay until Sunday at 2:00pm.
4. Health of all animals will be checked upon arrival and throughout their time on the fairgrounds. Any animal showing signs of illness will not be able to be shown and will need to leave the fairgrounds.
5. Exhibitors must have entries in place 30 minutes prior to the show.
6. Animals must have a tattoo in the animals' left ear. Any animal placed on the judging table without a tattoo will be disqualified.
7. All entries are final. Only substitutions in the same breed, sex, variety, and class can be made with approval of superintendent and no later than 30 minutes prior to the show.
8. Cages are limited in numbers with only one animal per cage unless instructed by the Superintendent.
9. The Standard of Perfection published by the American Rabbit Breeders Association will be used as a judging guideline for the show.
10. Crossbreeds and other breeds not recognized by the American Rabbit Breeders Association may be shown but are unable to compete for Best and Reserve in Show.
11. Youth and 4-H rabbits need to be placed on the judging table by a youth exhibitor. Please notify the Superintendent if the young are unable to attend the show.
12. All cages will be zip-tied at night. Zip ties will be provided by Superintendent.
13. Madison County Fair and the Superintendent will not be responsible in case of fire, theft, or accidents.
14. Premiums will be paid as follows: 1st -\$4, 2nd -\$3, & 3rd -\$2. Ribbons will be awarded 1st through 5th places.
