Late entries will be accepted for \$10.00. Entry fees are \$3.00 per class for calves & heifers and \$4.00 per class for cow/calf. **LATE ENTRIES MUST BE APPROVED BY THE SUPERINTENDENT.**

Exhibitors in this department are required to follow the Health Requirements. All animals must be accompanied by a Certificate of Veterinarian Inspection signed by an accredited veterinarian with animals individually identified. All animals will be inspected for contagious conditions, such as warts, ringworm, pink eye, lice, mange, respiratory infection, and contagious hoof conditions. **** NO BULLS OVER 1 YEAR OLD WILL BE ALLOWED TO SHOW! ****
